Dinner Diva

Some people become Internet stars because they can sing. Others become famous because they give great fashion advice. Park Seoyeon of South Korea is an Internet sensation because of how she eats her dinner.

In South Korea, family is the centre of life. According to Korean values, a person must always remember his family, and he shouldn't separate himself from them. This includes meals. Family meals are an important custom and it isn't acceptable for people to have meals alone. Even the Korean word for *family* [gajok] means "those who eat together". However, more and more South Koreans are moving away from home because of their jobs. They live alone and they have to eat by themselves. This goes against their beliefs, and people may feel embarrassed and lonely because of the situation.

Fortunately, Park Seo-yeon and others like her might have the perfect solution. Park, a woman in her thirties, has got her own Internet "eating show" with a huge community of followers. She started her show several years ago. At the time, she worked for a big company during the day and filmed the show in the evenings. Today, Park doesn't have to work for anyone else because she makes around \$9,000 a month eating meals at home, in front of a camera. While she eats, Park talks to her thousands of fans. They feel like they're sharing her meals, and they aren't embarrassed because they're eating alone. To show their appreciation, fans send Park gifts of virtual money which Park exchanges for real money. She must give some of that money to the Internet broadcasting site, but Park isn't complaining. She's now the number one dinner diva in the country. She's even invited her parents to join the show!
